Nature survey in area new proposed wind farm Curação

NuCapital's focus is the origination and development of new wind farms, solar PV projects, and integrated solutions in the Caribbean and Central and South America.



Rationale: NuCapital has signed a contract with a landowner in the northeast part of Curaçao for the erection of a wind farm. The area of concern is designated as "conservation area". To be able to make a well-considered decision with regard to the final configuration and location of the wind farm, NuCapital has asked EcoVision to assess the natural values in the concerned area.

Approach: A full year (2019) bi-weekly bird survey during morning and afternoon sessions has been performed ussing the point count method on 17 survey points. In addition, during 3 evenings bat presence was surveyed. During the bat surveys, presence of owls was monitored as well. The guidelines used for the field studies are the *Comprehensive guide to studying wind energy / wildlife interactions*, (Strickland et al., 2011) and the *U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Land-Based Wind Energy Guidelines* (U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, 2012). The vegetation in the area has been studied and mapped as well.

Outcome: Preferred layout options with respect to minimized impact on nature.

Recommendation do a study on the breeding least terns in the area.
