

Increasing attractiveness Christoffel Park for tourism

Carmabi is the management organization for the Curaçao Christoffelpark, Shete Boka Park and several other parks.



Rationale: With an area of almost 20 square kilometers, the Christoffel Park is the largest nature park on Curaçao. The natural values and the cultural-historical value of the Savonet landhouse form a unique combination of touristic elements. However, the current number of visitors is lower than the potential level.

Approach: The aim of the project is to increase the attractiveness of the Christoffel Park for tourism. EcoVision was requested to draw up a project dossier for Dutch funding. A number of projects were proposed such as: restoring parts of the hiking path to the mountain, preserving historical structures, expanding the restaurant, improving information signs and improving routes. EcoVision prepared investment budgets and carried out economic analyses in this project.

Outcome: The dossier was used for funding of most of these projects.
